What are the elements of the church?

PUBLIC PREACHING

- God brings life through His spoken Word (Genesis)
- God orders through His spoken Word (The Law)
- God calls through His spoken Word (Moses/Abram)
- The pattern of publically speaking God's words:
 - Nehemiah 8:1-8; "Thus Says The LORD"

PUBLIC PREACHING

- The authority of the Word affirmed by Christ (Matt 4)
- The pattern of preaching seen in the book of Acts
- The command to publically preach (2 Timothy 4:2)
- The results of public preaching (Romans 10:14-17)
