FINAL LESSONS

A Word about Judgement:

• This side of 'Final Judgement' (by Christ alone), every act of discipline is intended to reform and renew God's people. On this side of Final Judgement, as we live by the call to holiness and through the discernment of the Holy Spirit, no judgement is final.

FINAL LESSONS

A Word about Goodness:

- God disciplines us for our good, that we may share his holiness (Hebrews 12:10).
- And, what is good for us, is not often what pleases us, or makes us comfortable.

FINAL LESSONS

A Word about Christlikeness:

- Discipline is the vehicle God uses to admonish, rebuke and renew his people, and conform them more and more into the image of His Son.
- Discipline, thus, is an answer to our personal prayer, and our public desires for relational harmony.
